Masonic Trout and Salmon Fishing Charity West Kent Branch

The first event of 2026 was held at Spring Hill Trout Fishery on a **Monday 11th May** and was a fly-fishing event. The event was supported by 15 volunteers giving their time to make a successful event variously looking after the catering as well as coaches to cast for the guests. The hosted school was The Nexus School with 9 children and 4 teaching staff attending, led by Rebecca Platt.

The day started bright and Sunny but by mid-morning became very cloudy and windy making casting difficult at times. The water temperature was 16°C at the top and 15°C at the bottom. It was quite green and we could not see patrolling fish near the surface although on some occasions trout did leap out to catch flies on the surface. Here was evidence of trout fry and other species causing ripples across the surface. There were three rainbow trout caught on the day which were taken away for their families.



A convivial lunch was provided which was followed by presentations to every child a framed certificate of achievement and a goody bag.
